### **Research Projects Supported by the Wright Foundation**

1. Analyzing minimally invasive strabismus surgery technique outcomes.

2. Collaborative study between Tung Wah Eastern Hospital in Hong Kong and the Wright Foundation: diagnosis and management of cyclic esotropia.

### Education Projects Supported by the Wright Foundation

1. Fifth International Pediatric Ophthalmology and Strabismus Day Conference in Chicago, IL featuring Nobel Prize laureate Dr. Torsten Wiesel. Over 100 pediatric ophthalmologists from all over the world were in attendance.

2. Publication of the 3rd Edition of Pediatric Ophthalmology and Strabismus by Oxford University Press. The over 1000 page text is an authoritative authored by Dr. Wright and past student Dr. Yi Ning Strube.

3. Pediatric ophthalmology and strabismus fellowship training provided for international fellows, including doctors from both Serbia and Taiwan.

### **Clinical Care Supported by the Wright Foundation**

1. The community clinic experienced approximately 1200 clinic visits.

2. Approximately 155 surgeries were performed for minimal or no expense.

3. Approximately 135 therapeutic and medically necessary glasses or contact lenses were dispensed or repaired for minimal or no expense.

4. Dr. Deitz and Dr. Wright spent one week on a Panama Surgical Mission. While in Panama, the surgical team performed 120 strabismus and/or ptosis surgeries for children from Central Panama.
